- Inviting / meeting strangers or unauthorized persons inside the campus without written permission from the Principal is not allowed.
- Going into other classrooms or calling out students from there, during class hours without prior permission are not allowed.
- Littering classrooms / college premises with bits of papers, wrappers, plastic bottles etc are not allowed.

- Students should not attend or organise any meeting in the college or collect money without permission of the Principal.
- A grace time of 10 minutes will be given for students coming late.

- come late for more than 2 times. If late for the 3rd time the student should bring his/her parents to meet the Principal.
- Students should bring the college calender regularly to the college.

ATTENDANCE



HIS GRACE ARCHBISHOP BENEDICT MAR GREGORIOS

Archbishop Benedict Mar Gregorios was the Second Metropolitan Archbishop of the Syro-Malankara Catholic Church. He was born on 1st February 1916 at Kallooppara, Kerala. He assumed the name Benedict, which means blessed, and on 15 August 1935 he took his temporary religious vows (profession) before Archbishop Mar Ivanios. He was appointed the first Principal of Mar Ivanios College. In 1952, he was elected as Bishop. He was ordained as Remban in the Archbishop's House Chapel on 27 December 1952 and made Auxiliary Bishop of the Archieparchy of Trivandrum after the name Mar Gregorios. He became the Archbishop in January 1955. He received pallium, on 14th May 1959. He dedicated his priestly life to the service for the human society through his ministry. As Gregorians, it is oursole responsibility to fulfill the mission and vision of His Grace Archbishop Benedict Mar Gregorios
