#### STAFF ORIENTATION:




also she shared facts on how people took inspiration from her activities and they themselves started to grow tree and care for tree.

#### SPUTNIK V

#### Coronavirus

Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) is defined as illness caused by a novel coronavirus called severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2; formely called 2019-nCoV), which was first identified amid an outbreak of respiratory illness cases in Wuhan City. Hubei Province. China. It was initially reported to the World Health Organization(WHO) on December 31,2019. On January 30,2020, the WHO declared the COVID-19 outbreak a global health emergency. In India, the first case of COVID-19 was reported on 30 January 2020. India currently has the largest number of confirmed cases in Asia. As of May 2021, India has the second highest number of confirmed cases in the world (after the United States) with nearly 20million reported cases of COVID-19 infection and 218,959 deaths as of 3 May 2021.

#### **COVID-19** vaccination in India

India began administration of COVID-19 vaccines on 16 January 2021. As of 3rd May 2021, India has administered 158,932,921 doses overall, including first and second dose of the currently-approved vaccines. Two vaccines received approval for emergency use in India at the onset of the program, including Covishield (a version of the Oxford-AstraZeneca vaccine manufactured by the Serum Institute of India), and Covaxin (developed by Bharat Biotech). In April 2021, Sputnik V was approved as a third vaccine, with deployment expected to begin by late-May 2021.

#### So, What is Sputnik V?

In August 2020,Russia's President Vladimir Putin Surprised the world by approving its first domestically developed COVID-19 vacceine, and has a name intentionally invoking the space race of the 1950s. By the time the WHO declared COVID-19 a panademic, in March 2020, The Gamaleya National Center of Epidemilogy and Microbiology in Moscow was already working on a prototype of Sputnik V, funded by the Russian Direct Investment Fund(RDIF), the country's soveregin wealth fund.

Gamaleya researchers used common cold viruses in their vaccine prototype. Notably, they opted for two different adenovirus vectors (rAd26 and rAd5) delivered seperately in a first and second dose,21 days apart. Using the same adenovirus for the two doses could lead to the body developing an immune response against the vector and destroying it when the second dose is administered. To make the vaccine, the adenoviruses are combined with the SARS-CoV-2 spike protein, which prompts the body to make an immune response to it.



#### Is this Sputnik V vaccine safe and effective?

Phase I and Phase II results, on 76 participants of an open, non-randomised trial, were published in the Lancet in September. According to the paper, all participants developed SARS-CoV-2 antibodies. No serious adverse events were detected. Most adverse effects were mild, with just over half experiencing pain at the injection site.

Interim Phase

III data were published in early Febuary 2021. The randomised, double blind, placebo controlled trial included nearly 22,000 adults aged 18 years or older recruited through 25 hospitals and clinics in Moscow between 7 september and 24 November 2020. Each participant received either two doses of vaccine, or a placebo, which were sdministered 21 days apart.

Interim results (based on data so far from 14,964 participants in the vaccine group and 4902 in the placebo group) indicate that the vaccine is 91.6% effective,based on its ability to prevent symptomatic infection. There were no cases of moderate or severe

COVID-19 in the vaccinated group atleast 21days following the first dose. Some 94% of reported side effects were very mild(grade 1). Four deaths recorded during the study were found not to be related to the vaccine.

## Is Russia using the vaccine for their citizens?

On 2nd December, the same day the UK approved the Pfizer BioNTech vaccine for use, Putin declared that mass vaccination using Sputnik V,provided free to citizens, was to begin within days. Infact, administration of SputnikV began even earlier employees of Gamaleya were first people to receive prototype doses in the spring of 2020 before phase I and II trials took place in the summer.

The first members of the public to receive a dose of Sputnik V were school and healthcare workers. As of February, Russia had injected more than two million people with at least one dose of Sputnik V, according to the health Minister Mikhail Murashko.

#### Other countries using SputnikV:

Russia has gone to great lengths to promote SputnikV beyond its borders in a vaccine diplomacy drive, promising that it will cost less than \$10 per dose for international buyers. The RDIF says it signed contracts with more than a dozen manufacters in 10 countries to produce a total of 1.4 billion doses. At the time of writing,29 countries besides Russia had approved SputnikV for emergency use. That includes Hungary, the only EU state to do to date.



Sputnik V vaccine in India

India received its first lot of Sputnik V vaccine on 1st May 2021. The first batch of Russia-developed vaccine was delivered in Hyderbad as India battles a vicious second wave of COVID-19 infections."On 1st May 2021 India received 1,50,000 doses of Sputnik V vaccine here in Hyderbad.The vaccine will be available in a few weeks after it has gone through statutory clearances. The price will also be announced then",said Deepak Sapra of Dr.Reddy's Laboratories.



Dr.Reddy's has partnered with the Russian Direct Investment Fund(RDIF) to supply first 250 million doses of Sputnik V in India.

Sputnik V vaccine doses arrived on a day India started the process of vaccinating all citizens above 18 years of age against COVID-19. But the process is postponded due the election results. The country has so far offered two vaccines - Covishield and Covaxin to us.

"The efficacy of the Sputnik V in among the highest in the world, and this vaccine will also be effective against new strains of COVID-19",Russian Ambassador to India NickolayKudashev said on Saturday 1 May 2021, adding that "its local production is about to soon and is planned to be gradually increased upto 850 million per year".

- ➤ Cyberwar, also spelled cyber war, also called cyberwarfareor cyber warfare, war conducted in and from computers andthe networks connecting them, waged by states or theirproxies against other states.
- ➤ Cyberwar is usually waged against government and militarynetworks in order to disrupt, destroy, or deny their use.
- > Cyberwar should not be confused with the terrorist use of cyberspace or with cyberespionage or cybercrime.
- > Even though similar tactics are used in all four types ofactivities, it is a misinterpretation to define them all ascyberwar.
- ➤ Some states that have engaged in cyberwar may also haveengaged in disruptive activities such as cyberespionage, butsuch activities in themselves do not constitute cyberwar.
- ➤ Computers and the networks that connect them are collectively known as the domain of cyberspace.
- ➤ One of the first references to the term cyberwar can be foundin "Cyberwar Is Coming!," a landmark article by JohnArquilla and David Ronfeldt, two researchers for the RANDCorporation, published in 1993 in the journal ComparativeStrategy.

□ No physical present: In cyber warfare, attackers don't haven'ton ecessarily destroy the systems butjust disrupt them. Theydon't haveto physically enter the organization or a nationstate; they merely have to access the systems.

☐ Difficult to detect and hard to track: In the offensive mode, wemaynever even know who the attackers were; disinformationflow is very easy. If the attack is well planned and coordinated it is hard to find out where it came from and whois responsible for it.

- ☐ The Code Red worm. Attack from June to November 2001, infected more than 350,000 hosts in 24 hours, caused a lot oftraffic, clogging the bandwidth and slow downs on the Internet, affects computers running IIS Server (i.e. Win2000OS).
- □W32.Netsky.D@mm is a mass-mailing worm that is a variantofW32.Netsky.C@mm. The worm scans drives C through Zfor email addresses and sends it to those that are found. TheSubject ,Body, and Attachment names vary. The attachmentwill have a .pie file extension.
- ☐ WannaCry was a ransomware attack that spread rapidly inMay of 2017. Like all ransomware, it took over infectedcomputers and encrypted the contents of their hard drives, then demanded a payment in Bitcoin in order to decryptthem. The malware took particular root in computers atfacilities run by the United Kingdom's NHS.
