Enrolment Criteria: 100 Volunteers are enrolled every year. Both Boys and Girls are eligible to enrol.


Glimpses of Activities / Achievements

Training given on personality development and soft skills and organised awareness programs periodically.

To join IMA, candidates have to be declared successful by the Services Selection Board. The cadets with 'A' or 'B' Grade in 'C' certificate are exempted from CDS examination conducted by UPSC. 'C' Certificate holders to get 10-15 bonus marks in the direct entry examinations of the paramilitary forces like BSF, CISF, CRPF, SSB. The written examination will be waived off for the post of Soldier GD for the 'C' Certificate holders.

Application Process

- 1. VISIT college WEBSITE: www.mgcchennai.ac.in and CLICK Admission Icon.
- 2. Fill the APPLICATION FORM (U.G. /P.G.) carefully and furnish all the information needed.
- 3. CLICK the SAVE icon and note the REFERENCE NUMBER & PASSWORD for further communications.
- 4. SAVE & SUBMIT. Take a printout of the Application Form and submit it to the college after the payment of application fees. (online or offline)
- 5. Furnish all the information in the Application form after the declaration of the results of the 12th examination.
- 6. Submission of the original copies of the Transfer Certificate, 12th Mark Statement, and Conduct Certificate issued by the institution last attended are mandatory and photocopies of Aadhaar Card, Community Certificate, Migration Certificate/Eligibility Certificate (if applicable) at the time of admission and for PG courses, UG Mark Statements and Provisional/Degree Certificate.
- 7. The Overseas Candidates must submit photocopies of the Passport and Visa, proof of Residence in addition to the above documents. Overseas Candidates have to obtain an Eligibility Certificate from the University of Madras, No Objection Certificate from the Advisor of Foreign Students, which must be attached to the application form for admission to be considered. The admission is confirmed only after the submission of the Student's Visa from the Embassy.
- 8. The candidate applying for UG Courses has to be accompanied by the parent/guardian for admission.
- 9. The admission will be confirmed after the submission of the original documents and the payment of fees. FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED after admission.



WITHDRAWAL

A candidate once enrolled for a course is expected to complete the same. If the candidate withdraws the admission, he/she will be liable to pay the entire fee for the course.
